**COUNCIL CHAMBERS—Hahira, Georgia, May 5, 1983.**

An ordinance providing for Special Taxes or Occupation Taxes for Businesses transacted in the City of Hahira during the License year from June 1, to May 31, and for other purposes.

SECTION I—Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hahira, Georgia, that the following Licenses Tax or Occupation Tax shall be charged for the following Businesses transacted within the corporate limits of the City of Hahira during the license year from June 1, to May 31.

ANY BUSINESS not listed for the first year will be \$25.00 and will be rated at the next license year ordinance renewal.

BUSINESS LICENSES shall not be transferable and a transfer of ownership shall be considered in the same light as the termination of such business and the establishment of a new business. Therefore, a new license fee shall be required for the new owner of the business.

ANYONE engaged in any line of business, selling, buying, swapping, trading, disposing of or acquiring any article must maintain a regular building or be considered a peddler.

SECTION 2. No license above set shall be issued with an expiration date later than May 31, and no license shall be issued for a fractional part of the year for less than 50 percent of the annual rate specified, and this reduction to take place only when the business is entered into after December 1st.

SECTION 3. Classification of businesses will be determined according to its dominate businesses activity, that which provides the greatest percentage of the total gross receipts of your business.

SECTION 4. Be it further ordained, that any person, firm or corporation engaged in or transacting business or carrying on any of the trades, occupations, professions or calling herein above specified and for which a special license tax is required by this ordinance without having paid the same, and who shall fail or refuse to pay same on demand of the City Clerk, City Marshall or any collecting officer of the City of Hahira, shall be punished as provided by the City Charter.

SECTION 5. Be it further ordained, that all Special License Tax above provided for, must be paid by the first day of August. Any person failing to comply with this Section will be dealt with as provided by City Charter. The Mayor/Council not having authority to extend the time limit.

SECTION 6. Be it further enacted and ordained that all ordinances of said City in conflict with the foregoing, be and the same are hereby repealed.
