

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HAHIRA, GEORGIA

To amend certain provisions of Chapter 4 of the Code of the City of Hahira, Georgia, concerning alcoholic beverages; to provide for local regulation and permitted location of establishments selling or offering to sell malt beverages or other alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises by the drink; to repeal conflicting ordinances; and for other purposes,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hahira and it is hereby ORDAINED by the Authority thereof:

I.

The Code of the City of Hahira, Georgia, Chapter 4, Section 1(g)(2) is hereby deleted in its entirety, repealed, and replaced with the following section, to-wit:

Chapter 4, Section 1(g)(2). It shall be unlawful to sell or offer for sale, in or upon any licensed premises, any malt beverages or other alcoholic beverages of any kind, for consumption on the premises by the drink, EXCEPT within a zone located within the city limits of the City of Hahira, Georgia, located within a distance of 500 yards from a point located at the center of the intersection of the overpass of State Road No. 122 over Interstate Highway No. I-75.

II.

The Code of the City of Hahira, Georgia, Chapter 4, Section 1(g)(3) is hereby amended by striking the same in its entirety and replacing the same as follows, to-wit:

Chapter 4, Section 1(g)(3). No application for a license to sell malt beverages or other alcoholic beverages of any kind shall be granted for a proposed location which is within 300 feet of any church building or alcoholic treatment center owned and operated by the State of Georgia, Lowndes County, or the City of Hahira, or of any public playground; or within 600 feet of any school building, educational building, school grounds, or college campus. For purposes of this section, distances shall be measured by the most direct route of travel on the ground, and shall be between the property line of the proposed location and the property line of any school or school house, church, college campus or public playground, or any alcoholic treatment center owned and operated by the State of Georgia, Lowndes County, or the City of Hahira.

III.

This Ordinance shall become effective on the 7th day of August, 1986.

IV.

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
