ORDINANCE NUMBER 3-90

An Ordinance of the City of Hahira, Georgia

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hahira, Georgia, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of same, as follows:

The names of streets in the City of Hahira will not be considered for change unless a majority of the property owners living on the street presents a petition to the City Council requesting consideration for the change.

If a petition is submitted with a majority of the property owners living on the street requesting the name change, then the Mayor and City Council will call for a referendum to be submitted to a vote of the qualified voters of said City of Hahira, and if approved by a two-third vote of the qualified voters voting in said City, the street name will be changed as requested.

The referendum will be placed on the ballot for voters consideration at the first election held in the City of Hahira after a call for a referendum by the Mayor and Council of the said City of Hahira.

This ordinance read and adopted by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Hahira, Georgia at their regular meeting of the City Council of Hahira on the 15^{th} November 1990 by an unanimous vote.
