


ORDINANCE NO. 3-96

TO BE ENACTED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hahira, Georgia, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the Charter of the City of Hahira and the laws of the State of Georgia, a special non partisan election will be held in conjunction with the Lowndes County elections already scheduled for county, state, and federal elections. This special non partisan election shall be held on Tuesday, July 9, 1996, for the purpose of electing a council person for District 2 to fill the vacant post and unexpired term ending December 31, 1999. The polls will open at 7:00 A.M. Eastern Standard Time and close at 7:00 P.M. Eastern Standard Time. Terms for filing notice of candidacy are available at the office of the City Manager as City Hall, 102 South Church Street, Hahira, Georgia, between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. Monday, May 6, 1996 through Friday, May 10, 1996. Qualifying fee for the council post shall be \$26.25. Absentee voting shall be permitted in accordance with the Georgia Municipal Election Code. A run-off, if necessary, will be held on Tuesday, August 6, 1996, in accordance with the Georgia Municipal Election Code. Final date for persons to register to vote is Monday, June 10, 1996.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective on the 4 day of April, 1996.
