

ORDINANCE # 04 - 02

ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF HAHIRA REGARDING TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the authority of the Mayor and Council of the City of Hahira, pursuant to their authority, do hereby adopt the following amendment:

1.

Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinance of the City of Hahira, Georgia is hereby amended by striking in its entirety Section 2-111 entitled Transfer of Appropriations and substituting in lieu thereof the following so that as amended said ordinance shall read as follows:

**SECTION 2-111. TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

The City Clerk, City Manager or Accounting Clerk may at any time during the fiscal year transfer part or all of any unencumbered appropriation balance among programs within a department or office with the approval of the Mayor. Also, the City Council may by ordinance transfer part or all of any unencumbered appropriation balance from one (1) department or office to another, Except that no appropriation for debt service or capital improvements may be reduced or transferred during any fiscal year, and under no circumstances may the expenditures exceed the total of the budget.

2.

All ordinances, parts of ordinances, or regulations in conflict herewith are repealed.

3.

Should any section or provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof which is not specifically declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.



It is the intention of the Mayor and Council, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances, City of Hahira, Georgia and the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.


5.
