

ORDINANCE 12 - 04-05

**TO AMEND THE 2010 CITY OF HAHIRA CHARTER TO MODIFY ELECTION DISTRICTS, TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Hahira has the authority under home rule powers stipulated in the Official Code of Georgia, Annotated to modify its municipal charter according to form and content, as outlined in Section 36-35-3(b)(1) and to reapportion election districts following publication of the 2010 Census pursuant to O.C.G.A. §36-35-4.1; and

Whereas, the required advertising and public hearing process outlined in OCGA §36-35-3(b) has been executed; and

Whereas, a copy of the proposed amendment to the charter has been made available in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Hahira, and the office of the Clerk of the Superior Court for Lowndes County during the advertising period; and

Whereas, none of the proposed modifications in this amendment require the enactment of a local law by the General Assembly;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAHIRA, GEORGIA HEREBY ORDAINS as follows:**

I.

Section 2-11 of the Charter is amended as follows:

The existing four district descriptions in Section 2-11 shall be struck in their entirety and replaced with the following:

District 1: Beginning at the corner of the north city limits and west side of the railroad tracks and run south on the west side of the railroad tracks to West Lawson Street, then east on the south side of West Lawson Street to North Nelson Street, then south on west side of North and South Nelson Street to East Park Street, then west on north side of East Park Street to South Church Street, then south on west side of South Church Street to West Grace, then west on north side of West Grace to Judy Ann Drive, then south, west, and east, and north on the north of Judy Ann Drive to West Grace Street, then west on the north side of West Grace to South Hall Street, then south on West side of South Hall Street to south city limits and then west, north, and east along city limits to railroad tracks on north side of city.

District 2: Beginning at the southeast corner of Randall Street and Barfield Street, then east on south side of Randall Street to Short Street, then south on west

side of Short Street to East Grace Street, then east along the south side of East Grace Street to South Hagan Bridge Road, then north, east, south, and west along city limits to the east side of the railroad tracks, then north on east side of the railroad tracks to West Coleman Street, then east on south side of West Coleman Street to Tillman Street, then north on east side of Tillman Street to South Church Street, then west on east side of South Church Street to Jacquelyn Street, then east on the south side of Jacquelyn Street to Barfield Street, and north on the east side of Barfield Street to Randall Street.

District 3: Beginning at southeast corner of North Nelson Street and East Lawson Street, then east on the south side of East Stanfill Street to North Hagan Bridge Road, then south on west side of North Hagan Bridge Road to East Grace Street, then west on north side of East Grace Street to Short Street, then north on the east side of Short Street to Randall Street, then west on south side of Randall Street to Barfield Street, then south on west side of Barfield Street to Jacquelyn Street, then west on north side of Jacquelyn Street to South Church Street, then south on the west side of South Church Street to Tillman Street, then south on the west side of Tillman Street to West Coleman Street, then west on the north side of Coleman to the railroad tracks, then south on the west side of the railroad tracks to the city limits, then west, south, and north along city limits to South Hall Street, then north on east side of South Hall to West Grace Street, then east on south side of West Grace Street to Judy Ann Drive, then south, west, and east on the south of Judy Ann Drive to West Grace Street, then east on the south side of West and East Grace Streets to South Church Street, then north on the east side of South Church Street to East Park Street, then east on the south side of East Park Street to South Nelson Street, and north on South and North Nelson to East Lawson Street.

District 4: Beginning at the northeast corner of north city limits and railroad tracks, then south on east side of railroad tracks to West Lawson, then east on north side of West Lawson and East Lawson to East Stanfill, then east on north side of East Stanfill to North Hagan Bridge Road, then south on the east side of North Hagan Bridge Road to Highway 122, then east on north side of Highway 122 to east city limits, then north and west along city limits to railroad tracks.

II.

All other provisions of the Section 2 of the Charter shall remain in full force and effect except as amended hereby.

III.

This Ordinance shall become effective for election of members to the municipal governing authority at the next regular general municipal election.


IV.
