A. BROOKRIDGE DRIVE SEWER FORCEMAIN RELOCATION BID AUTHORIZATION-SPLOST VIII

City Manager Sumner stated this road is on the County paving list and part of the road was annexed into the City. We have a forcemain on the East side of the dirt road that must be relocated, it is the City's responsibility. The Engineer was working to help get us an estimate in January and February to have it done before paving begins. We have a quote from Little River Contractors in the amount of \$95,000. This item would be paid out of SPLOST VIII. **Councilman Davis made a motion to approve \$95,000 bid from Little River Contractors with piping size change which was seconded by Councilmember White. Councilmember White, Councilman Barfield, Councilman Davis and Mayor Pro Tem Rosatti all voted in favor of the motion.**
